Covid-19 Update - December 22, 2021

Friends at Central Park Church,

It has been a few months since we last adjusted our Covid-19 guidelines. With the pandemic continuing and the Omicron variant beginning to appear in Michigan, the Exec Team and Supervising Consistory want to remind everyone of our current guidelines as well as to clarify and strengthen them a bit.

Covid-19 Guidelines – December 14, 2021

- Encourage voluntary masking in the facility. Masks are available at the entrances to the sanctuary.
- Encourage everyone to self-monitor for Covid-19 symptoms and avoid social settings when they are sick.
- Encourage social distancing where possible. Hold meetings & groups larger/open spaces. Spread out in the sanctuary.
- If a person tests positive for Covid-19 and has been a part of worship or other activity at Central Park Church, they are encouraged to contact anyone they have been in “close contact” with in the preceding 1-2 days. “Close contact” is defined by the CDC as being within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes. Making such contacts is an individual responsibility, not a church responsibility.

We have all been through this for quite a while now. Let’s all use our best judgement to stay safe and help keep the people around us safe as well. Thanks for working together to keep on engaging in life and ministry here at Central Park Church.
