#### Communication with Congregation

The Consistory met on Tuesday, December 9, 2025 and offers the following highlights from the meeting:

#### **General Information:**

- 1.The Consistory is working together with the Executive Team on a preliminary Pastor Job Description. We plan to work on a survey for the congregation to give feedback as to what you are looking for in a called pastor.
- 2. The Executive team is planning to present the Church Profile at the Congregational Meeting on 12/14/25.
- 3. Central Park and Park Church met on 12/11/25 to discuss our continued partnership for ministry.
- 4. The Community Relations and Mission Team continues to work on future plans for the Indoor Pantry.

# The Consistory has approved the following items:

- 1. The Proposed Preaching Schedule for 2026.
- 2. Joint worship with Park Church on Maundy Thursday, 4/2/26.
- 3. The Vision for Mission Fund grant allotment of \$10,750 (as recommended by the Finance Team).
- 4. The recommendation that up to \$2200 for the Youth Group Cran Hill High School and Middle School retreats and up to \$3900 for the Youth Group Summer Mission trip to Nashville be provided from the 2026 Vision for Mission Fund.
